

EU Settlement Scheme

Following the United Kingdom (UK) leaving the European Union (EU), European Economic Area (EEA) nationals and dependents need to apply to the EU Settlement Scheme to be able to continue legally living, working and claiming benefits in the UK. The deadline for applications was 30th June 2021.

The deadline has now passed...

If you have not yet applied to the scheme

you have until the 28th July 2021 to make a late

application. If you do not do this in time you

may not have any legal basis to remain in the UK.

You are an EEA national if you are a citizen of any of the following states:

Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, The Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Romania, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden or Switzerland.



You do NOT need to apply if you have been granted Indefinite Leave to Remain (ILR), if you are Irish, or if you have dual UK/EU nationality. But you DO need to apply if you have a permanent residence card (which is not valid after 31st December 2020).
