

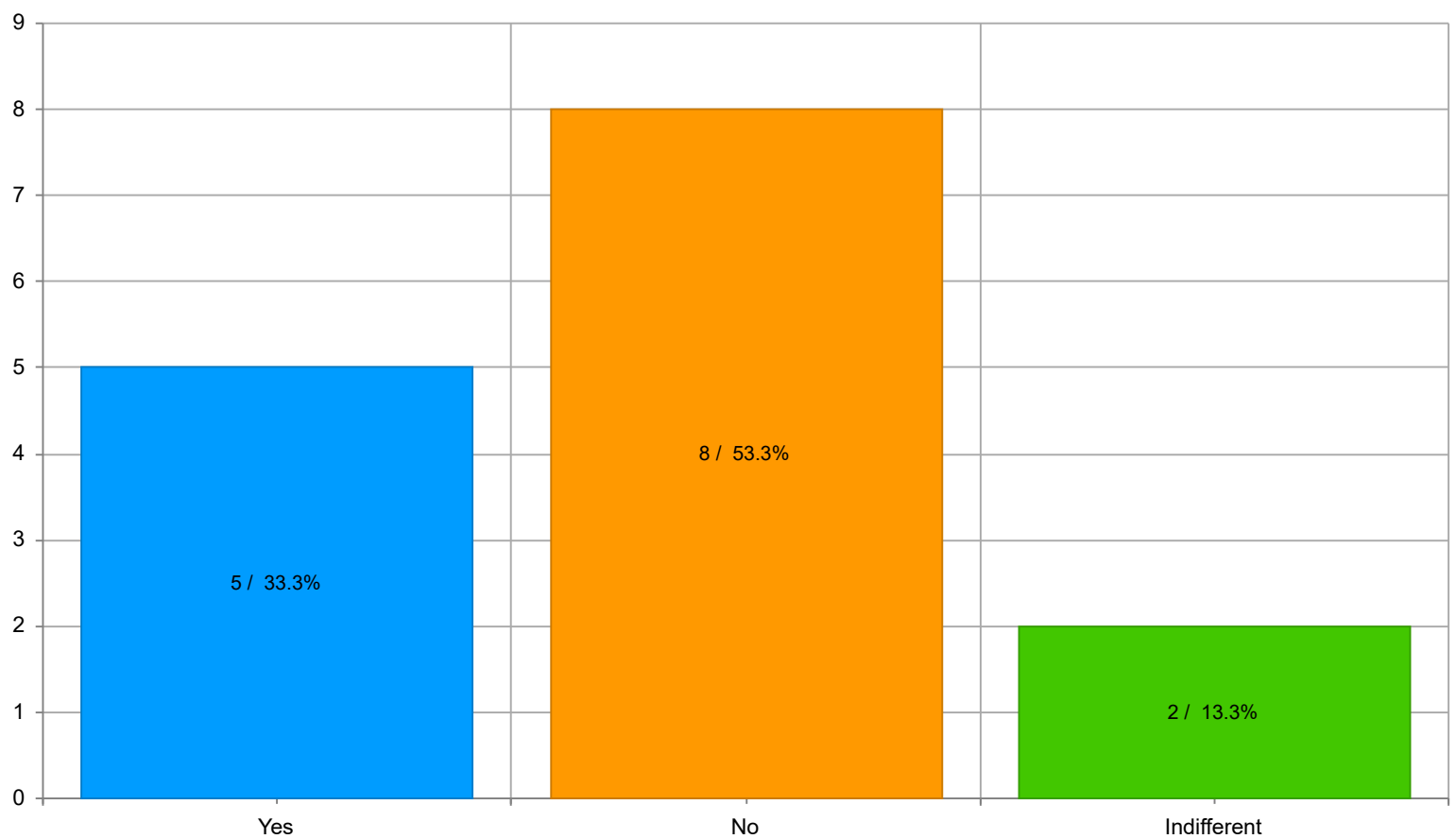


Tindale Drive - Reduced Grass Cutting Trial
